

Disability Action Transport Services

What you need to know

- DATS is a service in towns for people who find it difficult to use public transport
- You must join the scheme before you use it
- Transport used for the service is accessible to disabled people including wheelchair users
- You usually can only travel within a local area
- You usually have to book a journey at least the day before
- Drivers will assist you to and from the vehicle
- DATS costs £2.30 per trip
- You cannot use your Translink Smartpass on DATS
- DATS is currently available in all towns and cities in Northern Ireland with a population over 10,000

Things to think about

- Check DATS is available in your area
- Check if you are eligible to join the scheme
- Check if DATS is available for the journey you want to make
