What you need to know

- Shopmobility schemes offer the loan of scooters, wheelchairs and mobility aids
- Schemes are usually based in town centres or shopping centres
- Anybody with limited mobility, temporary or permanent, can use Shopmobility
- You will have to join the Scheme before you use it
- You will receive training on how to use the equipment
- You may have to pay a small membership fee but use of equipment is free

- Check how you will get to and from the Shopmobility scheme
- Check what times your local schemes operates
- You will need some identification to join
